
### **Blackout Poetry**

A **blackout poem** is when a **poet** takes a marker (usually black marker) to already established text–like in a newspaper–and starts removing words until a **poem** is formed.

The key thing with a **blackout poem** is that the text AND covered up text form a sort of visual **poem**.


#### 10.40 - The Turing School - who is Alan Turing?

Our school is named after a man called Alan Turing.

### 12.30 - Silent reading - Go Big

You should have all had a copy of the book - Go Big. Please spend 30 minutes reading this book. Once you have read for 30 minutes you are to write a short piece of writing about the book so far.

If you don't have a copy choose your favourite reading book and complete the same task .

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### 1.00pm - Science

For you science task - you will need some equipment, so go and find

2x 100ml of cold water.

1 x measuring jug.

2x 1 teaspoon of salt or sugar.

A stopwatch or a phone with a timer.

A kettle.

2 x beakers which can contain water (one must be able to hold hot water so this could be a mug)

Method: -

- 1) Measure 100ml of cold water in a measuring jug.
- 2) Pour the cold water into a beaker/glass/mug.
- 3) Add 1 teaspoon of salt or sugar and start your stopwatch/timer.
- 4) Time how long it takes for salt/sugar to stop dissolving.
- 5) Record this time.
- 6) Now repeat this with the hot water from the kettle (you will need a adult to help you pour the boiling water into your beaker).

Results: -
