



- School blazer with the The Turing School logo (Must be worn at all times)
  - White Shirt (Undergarments should not be visible through the white shirt)
  - Black pleated/ straight skirt down to the knee (no stretchy material or pencil skirts are permitted); or black, loose-fitting trousers. (no jeans or chinos)
  - Black V neck jumper with the Turing School logo (Optional)
  - The Turing tie (must be worn at all times)
  - Black socks only, no white socks allowed
  - Plain black leather formal shoes with no flashes, colours and must be low heel (no trainers allowed, even if leather, see below for further guidance)
  - Hair styles must not be extreme in either cut or colour, no excessive make-up or false eyelashes
  - No jewellery or piercings allowed, No false nails or nail varnish
  - Sportswear Compulsory (Turing branded training top and Turing branded shorts or Turing leggings. (training pants and skorts optional).  
No other non Turing items allowed).
- On colder days students can wear optional Turing PE jumpers or long sleeved Turing training tops.*

**Coats and Jackets:** Coats and jackets may be worn on the way to & from School but must be removed immediately on entering the School buildings. We do not allow hoodies to be worn at any point in school.

**Shoes:** All pupils should wear plain black, leather shoes with dark soles and, if applicable, black laces. Black plimsolls or shoes that have a trainer look are not an acceptable alternative and are strictly not allowed. Boots must not be worn. In exceptional cases, alternative footwear will be permitted only if a letter from a doctor can be shown. (Students can wear trainers for PE with minimal logos and colours).

**Mobile Phones:** Students are not permitted to have their mobile phone on or out of their bags at any point during the day including breaks. Mobile phones will be confiscated and kept in the school safe for parents to collect if students use them at any time. This also covers headphones & earphones.
